We are thrilled to offer you our beautiful **Sleeping Beauty turquoise**. This Arizona mine closed several years ago and these magnificent natural stones have become very collectible. We also offer a few small stones that are a perfect color match to Sleeping Beauty, but are stabilized turquoise. These stones are naturally softer, and wouldn't be durable if not infused with a stabilizing treatment. We always disclose which stones are Sleeping Beauty and which are other turquoise.
